1. Discussion on the International Conference in Rome and mention of conference in NYC, on **23rd September 2016**.
2. Next Hour of Reflection scheduled for Wednesday **19th October** at 6 pm, at Mount St Joseph, with Fr Mark Sultana.
3. Preparation meeting on **23rd August** 5 pm, at MISCO, for meeting with Archbishop
4. Meeting with HG Archbishop Scicluna on Tuesday **6th September** 10:30 am till 11:30 am
5. Year End Holy Mass and dinner on Monday **5th December** at 7 pm, place and restaurant to be announced.
6. Planning Meeting re: Course on Politics & the Common Good, Tuesday **5th July** at, 5 pm, MISCO offices
7. Plan a **strategic meeting** for CAPPF in Malta, to map out the next 3- 5 years, inspired by the document prepared by CAPPF- USA, outlining vision and objectives.
8. Reaching out to friends/members of CAPPF in Malta (we have around 40 people on our mailing list) what can be done to encourage more involvement?
9. Initiative to address Standards in Public Life, covering society in general and including politics, professions, business and banking, NGOs and unions.
 - Workshop session (2 hours from 8:30 am to 10:30 am) with a core group: to have a brief presentation for 20 min, followed by debates or brainstorming session, discussion and concluding remarks by chairperson, or invited guest (such as HG Archbishop Scicluna). Joseph FX Zahra to speak to Archbishop about this initiative.
 - The material and ideas generated by this workshop session will be then presented to a wider audience in a seminar and/or paper.
10. A seminar on Centesimus Annus 25th Anniversary, or on things that Pope Francis mentioned to us (i.e. new economy, etc.)
11. Invitation to Monsignor Claudio Maria Celli to come to Malta for an event, possible Lenten retreat in 2017.
12. Collaboration with CUA, Prof Andrew Abela. Mark DeMicoli to discuss with Professor Abela next month in Washington DC.
13. Etienne Dalli suggested possible online courses, or initiative to create short videos with teachings on Social Doctrine, or Business Ethics.
